

PUBLIC NOTICE OF CITY CLERK/TREASURER VACANCY AND INTENT TO FILL

Approved by the City Council this 18th Day of May, 2023, Langley, Oklahoma

This is formal notice that the Langley City Council intends to fill a City Clerk/Treasurer vacancy caused by the resignation of Amanda Witt. Ms. Witt's resignation is effective May 18th, 2023. The City Council intends to appoint a replacement at 6:00 PM on June 1, 2023 at City Hall during the regularly scheduled Council meeting. This will be an open meeting and members of the public are invited to attend.

This notice is posted until June 1, 2023 at 5:00 pm. at City Hall & the City web site inviting all interested and qualified parties to apply for this vacancy.

To qualify for this vacancy, you must submit a letter of intent during normal office hours at City Hall. Minimum requirements to be considered are: 1. Be United States Citizen and a registered voter over 18 years of age, with primary residence in Langley, Oklahoma for a period of no less than the previous 6 months. 2. Written submission declaring your desire to fill the vacant clerk/treasurer seat.

Please submit a letter expressing your desire to serve to: Town Hall, Attn: Clerk/Treasurer application, P.O. Box 760, Langley, Oklahoma, 74350. This declaration of candidacy and any related materials you wish to submit must be physically received by Town Hall not later than 5PM, June 1, 2023.

Also be advised that whoever is selected will be appointed through May 1, 2025. If they wish to serve after that point, they will be required to file for the general election in the spring of 2025.
