2. Department reports:

Police dept: Cody reported there were 57 calls, 51 contacts, 110 traffic stops, 21 citations, 95 warnings, 15 agency assists, 4 misdemeanor arrests, 0 felony arrests, & 486 hours worked. Cody also reported that David Arnold resigned on October 31, 2023, effective immediately.

Park dept: Miller reported that PSO installed a new pole in the park to replace the damaged one, we will have the cameras moved to the new pole soon. Miller also stated that he's been getting quotes for park improvements.

Street dept: We've applied for a \$1,500 walk America grant to paint a pedestrian lane from park to park. We've also applied for a REAP grant for repairing/repaving Lakeview ave., Church st. and Broadway.

Library report: Mary reported the TWEENS, DIY, ARTS AND CRAFTS will meet on November 6<sup>th</sup> to paint Harvest Signs. Curious Minds STEAM CLUB will meet on November 27<sup>th</sup> for a build a Turkey Cage challenge. Mary also stated the Langley Public Library was chosen to participate in the ALL 50 2022 Project called "Bill". "Bill" Is a one-dollar bill making its way to all 50 states, one rural library at a time, one in each state. This project brings awareness of small rural libraries and their values to the community. Langley Public Library received from Governor Stitt the Governor's Commendation for representing the State of Oklahoma.


Grapevine stated the 2024 Holiday schedule will be tabled until next month.
